1. Selection is to be done as per the guidelines of DHE office vide letter no. 7/21-2015 NPE(1) dated 03.06.2015.
2. For preparing merit 10% of the percentage of each class from Matric upto P.G. i.e. 10th, 10+2, U.G.& P.G., is to be considered for calculating percentage of the candidate.
3. A written test of 40 marks will be conducted to assess the candidate's proficiency computer and knowledge of English Language.
4. The marks obtained in the test will be added as such to the 10% of the percentage of the each class from 10th upto P.G.
5. The questionnaire for conducting test will be prepared jointly by the Language Lab Committee and Mrs. Ruchi Singla, Computer Instructor.
6. No extra mark to be awarded for B.Ed./STET/Higher Qualification/Experience/Interview etc.

Criteria for the Panel of Resource Persons purely on Extension Lectures Bases

Session 2015-16

1. The first preference will be given to NET/SET qualified candidates.
2. The second preference will be given to candidates who have completed Ph.D provided that they are otherwise eligible.
3. In case two or more candidates in the merit list have equal percentage of marks, the Candidate senior in age will be considered first.
4. For preparing the panel, the merit will be calculated as under:

(i) Academic record masters level degree (Max marks 10)

- (a) 55+ to 60% ----- 2 marks
- (b) 60+ to 65% ----- 4 marks
- (c) 65+ to 70% ----- 6 marks
- (d) 70+ to 75% ----- 8 marks
- (e) Above 75----- 10 marks

(ii) Good Academic record (Max marks 10)

- (a) 1st division in all the three lower exams prior to master degree—10 marks
- (b) 1st division in two lower exams- 7 marks
- (c) 1st division in one lower exam - 3 marks

(iii) Weightage for Additional / higher qualification (Max.10 marks)

- (a) Ph.D - 10 marks
- (b) M.Phil.- 5 marks

(iv) Teaching experience (Max.15 Marks)

Two marks will be given for teaching experience of every academic semester. Teaching work (at college or university level only) for at least three months per semester will be considered for weightage. This weightage will be given only to those candidates who submit their experience certificates issued by principal of college/Institute/ Department.

(V) Publication (Max .10 Marks)

- (a) Subject books (ISSN/ISBN) – 03 marks for each book.
- (b) Research paper in referred international journal (ISSN/ISBN---- 02 Marks for each publication.
- (c) Research paper in referred national journal (ISSN/ISSN) ----- 01 Mark for each publication.

(VI) Co-Curricular Activities (Max. 05 marks)

- (a) Youth Festival recommended--- 01 mark for each item
- (b) Debate/Declamation/Quiz/Poetic Recitation/Literacy & Fine Arts, State level/University position. ---01 mark for each item
- (c) N.C.C. (C Certificate) -----02 Marks
- (d) N.S.S Certificate (University Merit Certificate)—02 Marks

(VII) Sports (Max. 05 Marks) (only for those games which are recognised by K.U.K.)

- (a) Position at national level---- [1st position- 5marks, 2nd position- 3 Marks, 3rd position- 2 marks]
- (b) Position at university Level--- [1st position-03 marks, 2nd position-02 marks, 3rd position- 01 mark]









Minutes of the meeting held on 06.02.2016

A joint meeting of the College Council and NSS Advisory Committee was held on 06-02-2016 under the chairmanship of the undersigned regarding the organization of Seven -Day Special NSS camp. The following issues were discussed and unanimous decisions were taken thereafter:

- (1) The NSS Incharge, Smt. Karunesh, Asst. Prof. of English, informed that the college had not received any grant for organization of the Seven Day Special NSS camp for any of the three units of College. This camp is mandatory for NSS volunteers to get the university merit certificate. Keeping in view the interest of the students, it was decided in unison that the camp will be organized out of the college NSS fund. A request will be made to the Department of the Higher Education Haryana to release the NSS grant at the earliest. This grant, whenever received, will be deposited in the NSS fund.
- (2) It was also decided in the meeting that The College Annual Athletics meet will be held on 23rd and 24th February 2016. Bhuteshwar function, the cultural function of the college held out of the grant sent by the Department of the Higher Education Haryana, will be organized on 25th Feb. 2016.
- (3) As the peaceful teaching atmosphere of the college has recently been disturbed by frequent visits of outside elements, it was proposed that a security guard should be deployed at the main entrance. A prior permission for the same is to be sought from the Department. It was also suggested that HD cameras should be installed at few fixed places in the college. An estimate should be sent to the department to get a grant for the said purpose.
