The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has become a driving force for ushering in quality by working out intervention strategies to remove deficiencies and enhance quality. All the quality assurance measures across academic, planning and administration, which were earlier independently monitored and executed at different levels, are now supervised by the IQAC. - Students should be trained to earn money by engaging themselves in productive activities.
